

Madison Village Damaged Mailbox Policy

As snowplows take to the roads this winter season, Madison Village is reminding residents of its policy regarding damaged mailboxes.

If a supervisor from Madison Village determines that a Madison Village snowplow was at fault for damaging a properly installed and maintained mailbox, Madison Village will replace a 4 by 4 inch treated wooden post and a mailbox approved by the United States Postal Service, or a settlement up to \$50.00.

The damage must be caused by a direct hit from a vehicle or snowplow blade, not by thrown or pushed snow.

To be considered properly installed, the face of the mailbox must be 12 inches to 18 inches from the edge of the pavement, cannot be mounted on anything larger than a 4-inch-by-4-inch post of 2 inch diameter steel pipe, be installed no deeper than 24 inches into the ground and not be encased in concrete.
