

**ORDINANCE NO. 17 - 2015**

**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF INSIGHT PIPE CONTRACTING, L.P. FOR CONTRACT "B," CIPP PIPE LINING & MANHOLE REHABILITATION, OF THE 2015 SANITARY SEWER REHABILITATION PROJECT, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH SAME AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to prior Ordinance advertisement for bids for Contract "B," CIPP Pipe Lining & Manhole Rehabilitation, of the 2015 Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Project occurred; and

WHEREAS, said bids were publicly opened and read on April 3, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the lowest bidder was Insight Pipe Contracting, L.P. in the amount of Seventy-Seven Thousand Two Hundred Thirty-Six Dollars and Seventy Cents (\$77,236.70); and

WHEREAS, the Village Engineer, who opines that the company is a responsible bidder capable and qualified to perform the work and that its bid was in compliance with all bid, contract, and legal requirements, now recommends the contract be awarded.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MADISON, LAKE COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:


SECTION 1. That the bid of Insight Pipe Contracting, L.P. is hereby accepted for Contract "B" in the amount of \$77,236.70.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized to forthwith enter into a contract with Insight Pipe Contracting, L.P. in accordance with the specifications of the Village Engineer, the bid and contract documents for Contract "B."

SECTION 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Madison because repairs must be made forthwith so as to protect the integrity and functioning of the sanitary sewer system as well as to meet EPA requirements imposed upon its operation; wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and immediately upon passage.
