

**RESOLUTION NO. 19-2015**

**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE MOVING OF THE NAME  
RICHARD ALAN HAMBLIN FROM THE FORMER MADISON HIGH  
SCHOOL LOCATION (92 EAST MAIN STREET) TO THE CURRENT  
MADISON HIGH SCHOOL LOCATION (3100 BURNS ROAD)**

**WHEREAS**, the elected officials and employees of Madison Village honors the memory of Richard Alan Hamblin, born on March 5, 1947 in Madison, Ohio and;

**WHEREAS**, Richard Alan Hamblin grew up on his family farm on Dayton Road in Madison, Ohio; and;

**WHEREAS**, Richard Alan Hamblin attended Madison High School; graduating in 1966. He was a tackle on the Madison High School Varsity Football Team as a sophomore and also was a heavyweight wrestler for the Madison High School Wrestling Team, and;

**WHEREAS**, Richard Alan Hamblin entered the Marine Corp to serve his Country after graduating from Madison High School and he obtained the rank of Private First Class while serving in Southeast Asia, and;

**WHEREAS**, on September 21, 1967, during a mission in the Quang Tri Province, he and his platoon were ambushed and he along with an additional marines were killed, paying the ultimate price to their Country; and;

**WHEREAS**, Marine PFC Richard Alan Hamblin is interred at the Mentor Municipal Cemetery in Mentor, Ohio and is also remembered on the Vietnam Wall in Washington D.C. on panel 26 E, 102.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE
