

## ORDINANCE NO. 3- 2014

### AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF JASON CHAPMAN AS ADMINISTRATOR OF THE VILLAGE OF MADISON, OHIO, ESTABLISHING THE COMPENSATION FOR HIS SERVICES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Mayor has advised the Council that he has appointed Jason Chapman to the position of Village Administrator; and

WHEREAS, confirmation of the appointment by the Council is now requested by the Mayor pursuant to Article VI, §6.2 of the Village Charter.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MADISON, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the appointment of Jason Chapman to the position of Village Administrator be and is hereby confirmed.

SECTION 2. That Jason Chapman shall be paid and compensated as follows:

A. From the effective date of this Ordinance, Jason Chapman shall be paid on a salary basis of Forty-Nine Thousand Dollars (\$49,000.00) annually for his services, payable in equal bi-weekly installments during the term of his employment and at such times as Village payroll is generally processed.

B. That Jason Chapman shall be eligible for such benefits as are generally provided to salary-exempt full-time Village employees pursuant applicable Village ordinances, but, subject to such amendments, modifications, and/or repeals of same as may occur from time-to-time.

SECTION 3. That Jason Chapman's term of employment is subject to Article VI, §6.2 of the Village Charter and that said Charter section shall prevail over any such general Village employment policies or procedures as may be or appear to be in conflict with same. No term or provision contained in this Ordinance, express or implied, is intended nor shall it be interpreted as creating a contract of employment between the Village and Jason Chapman.

SECTION 4. That no bond shall be required.

SECTION 5. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 6. That this Ordinance constitutes an emergency in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Madison and is further necessary for the usual daily operation of the Village as specific Charter and other legal duties require the performance of a duly acting Administrator; WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take immediate effect in accordance with the provisions of Article V, §5.2 of the Madison Village Charter.
