

ORDINANCE 7- 2014

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF TWO KONICA MINOLTA COPIERS THAT ARE NO LONGER NEEDED FOR ANY PUBLIC USE

WHEREAS, the Village owns two copiers, to wit: a Konica Minolta C360 and a Konica Minolta C353; and

WHEREAS, the Village has taken these machines out of service due to their replacement with two new copier machines; and

WHEREAS, given that the Village has no further use for the two Konica Minolta machines it is hereby determined that they are no longer needed for any public purpose and should be sold.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MADISON, COUNTY OF LAKE AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Administration shall offer the Konica Minolta C353 for public sale in "as is" condition to the highest and best bidder in accordance with the requirements of Ohio Revised Code §721.15(A). The Administration is hereby authorized to set a reserve price as a condition of offer of sale in an amount that it may determine is warranted by the probable fair market value of the machine.

SECTION 2. That the Madison Joint Fire District (MJFD), a political subdivision serving territory that includes the Village, has expressed its interest in acquisition of the Konica Minolta C360 for public use. The Administration is hereby authorized pursuant to Ohio Revised Code §735.053 to negotiate the sale of the Konica Minolta C360 in "as is" condition for a price as mutually agreed, provided the MJFD shall thereafter use the machine for public use for its reasonable service life, as determined by the MJFD.

In the event the Administration and MJFD fail to reach an agreement, then, the Administration shall offer the Konica Minolta C360 for public sale in "as is" condition to the highest and best bidder in accordance with the requirements of Ohio Revised Code §721.15(A). The Administration is hereby authorized to set a reserve price as a condition of offer of sale in an amount that it may determine is warranted by the probable fair market value of the machine.

SECTION 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.
