ORDINANCE NO. 35 - 2016

**AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF
JEFFERY A. BUTRAM AS A PART-TIME PATROLMAN
FOR THE MADISON VILLAGE POLICE DEPARTMENT
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Jeffery A. Butram applied for a position as a part-time patrolman with the Madison Village Police Department; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor has appointed Jeffery A. Butram as a part-time patrolman for the Madison Village Police Department and the Council desires to confirm the appointment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MADISON, COUNTY OF LAKE AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. The appointment of Jeffery A. Butram as a part-time patrolman for the Madison Village Police Department be and hereby is confirmed.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including § 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Madison, and further necessary in order to maintain necessary staffing levels and the efficient daily operation of the Police Department; wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage.
